Goals of SPSA were reviewed by Pixie.

1. We will increase by 10 percentage points combined the number of students demonstrating proficiency in meeting or exceeding grade level expectations as set by the California State Standards in Reading, Writing, Listening, and Speaking as measured by CAASPP in grades 3-6 and Grade Level Benchmark Assessments in grades K-2.
 2. We will increase by 10 percentage points combined the number of students demonstrating proficiency in meeting or exceeding grade level expectations as set by the California State Standards in Mathematics as measured by CAASPP in grades 3-6 and Grade Level Benchmark Assessments in grades K-2.
 3. Increase student engagement and well-being by providing enriching learning and leadership opportunities, by providing a safe and caring learning environment where families feel welcomed and where students are focused on meeting rigorous academic targets.
- Pixie shared that the Title I program had focused on Language Standards September through December, but would now focus on Foundational Math for January through May. An Imagine Learning computer lab is being established, and we plan to hire a Title I aide to assist students in the lab. Imagine Learning is a researched based computer program that is adaptive to each student's level. As students master concepts, they move forward in the program. The Title I aide will monitor that growth and communicate it with students and teachers.
 - The group discussed ways to encourage parent involvement, especially with our second language families. We currently use School Messenger, Facebook, posted announcements and information sent home to inform parents of events.
